Sir,

I am to state that the Council Inspector report (July 1989) on the standard of examination and the facilities for teaching existing at Goa Medical College, Panaji together with the observations of the University and recommendations of the Postgraduate Committee for purposes of recognition of M.D.(Pathology) granted by Goa University and also proviso of the College for the award of above qualification earlier granted by Bombay University was duly placed before the Council at its meeting held on 4th Jan., 1992, for consideration. The Council approved the following recommendations of the Postgraduate Committee, which I am directed to forward herewith for your information and necessary action in the matter:-

"The Postgraduate Committee recommends that M.D. (Pathology) qualification granted by Goa University in respect of students being trained at Goa Medical College, Panaji be recognised and included in the Ist Schedule to the I.M.C. Act., 1956.

The following note may be added in the Government notification.

This M.D.(Pathology) qualification shall be a recognised when granted on and after 1st Feb., 1990.

With the request to implement the various recommendations and suggestions made by the Council Inspector in the inspection report. The student teacher ratio for degree and/or diploma as prescribed in the regulations of the Council on Postgraduate Medical Education should be strictly adhered to and the students should be admitted only against recognised postgraduate teacher as per Medical Council of India regulations. However, no increase of seats to be made without prior approval of the Council. Since Goa Medical College, Panaji was earlier affiliated to Bombay University and permitted by the Council to start various postgraduate medical courses under that university, the Postgraduate Committee recommends that Goa Medical College, Panaji be approved for the award of the above qualification earlier granted by Bombay University."
